**NOTIFICATION**

In order to ensure coordinated, cost-effective and convergent implementation of the National e-Governance Action Plan initiated by the Department of IT, Government of India as well as other initiatives in the field of e-Governance from any other resources from the State Government, Government of India, other funding agencies etc. in a time bound manner and adherence to the norms regarding deliverables in various NeGP Projects (including Capacity Building), the Governor of Himachal Pradesh is pleased to notify the institutional frame-work of NeGP as per **Annexure-A** to this notification.

2. The Governor of Himachal Pradesh is further pleased to constitute State e-Mission Team and to notify that linkages among various bodies and organisations shall be as follows:

**1. Expanded SITEG Executive Committee:**

It will have the same composition as EC of SITEG (Society for IT and e-Governance) with addition of Heads of Department of all those departments whose projects are undertaken in NeGP or any other kind of e-Governance Projects referred to in para 1 above. This Committee will work along with Department of IT and the concerned line department and in accordance with broad policy, vision and strategy direction given by **State Programme Steering Council** and **SeGP Apex Committee** notified separately vide notification no. DIT (SWAN-SITEG) 21/2005 dated 14.03.2006. All the inter-departmental linkages and convergence in approach can be ensured by deliberations in this body within the ambit of policy & procedure frame-work laid down by the IT Department. As per

*Abw*

the instructions of the State Government issued by the Finance Department, all departments, boards and corporations shall seek advice of the IT Department in techno-commercial matters while conceptualising and implementing an e-Governance Project. Thus, the expanded SITEG will provide a platform for better interaction and thorough deliberations between the IT Department and the Departmental Committees set up as per point no. 3 below.

In case of an issue requiring approval at the Government level in a line department, the concerned HOD will get the needful done through his Secretary. Any unresolved issue will be escalated to the SeGP Apex Committee for appropriate directions. District e-Governance Societies shall have linkages with SITEG as show in **Annexure-A**.

**2. State e-Mission Team (SeMT):** The composition of a full time State e-Mission Team shall be as follows:

- (i) Director IT : Chairperson
- (ii) State Informatics Officer : Member
- (iii) *Additional / Joint Director IT* : Member
- (iv) Senior Manager IT : Member
- (v) Manager IT : Convener
- (vi) Deputy Director, STPI : Member
- (vii) Deputy Manager IT : Member
- (viii) All other IT and other professionals specially engaged in SeMT on contract, secondment, consultancy or wet lease basis : Members

**SeMT shall be a full time advisory body in the Department of IT/SITEG for undertaking e-Governance Projects.** SeMT is expected to provide strength and continuity to the IT Department by way of 5 to 10 core people initially and also with the help of outsourced consultancy. It will also address the issues relating to interdependencies, overlaps, conflicts, standards, overarching architecture, security, legal aspects, etc. These objectives are sought to be achieved by integrating Heads of

Departments undertaking e-Governance Projects in the Executive Committee of SITEG as proposed in point no. 1 above. SeMT will also help and advise PeMT in techno-commercial matters, ensure consistency in approach among various projects and also provide advantage of economies of scale in procurement of hardware, software and networking.

**3. Departmental Committee:** This Committee headed by the concerned Head of the Department shall comprise of the other departmental officials and domain / technical experts within the Department. It shall oversee and monitor project execution by carrying out periodical review with PeMT. One member of SeMT shall also be a part of this Departmental Committee, so as to ensure proper coordination and continuity.

**4. Project e-Mission Team (PeMT):** PeMT (a full time body within the Department headed by a Project Leader to be designated by the HOD for each project separately) would manage implementation and deal with technology, process and change management related issues. In particular, it would also manage following tasks by either using in-house skills or by outsourcing with the aid and advice of IT Department / SITEG through SeMT:

- Preparation of Project Proposals
- Business Process Re-engineering, Change Management, Financial Modelling, System Design, software Development etc.
- Training
- Data Entry

The team would typically consist of about 3 to 4 core people and have a well-balanced mix of domain expertise. It will be set up by the Departments concerned at the earliest. PeMT shall continuously liaise with SeMT to get the assistance as described in point no. 2 above. Initial expenditure on PeMT

can be met from Additional Central Assistance provided by the Government of India for capacity building to the SITEG. However, such an expenditure on PeMT can be met out of ACA till the sanction of a Project by the competent authority. After sanction of a Project, the expenditure incurred on PeMT shall be met from within the Project cost. For the ongoing e-Governance projects, the ACA fund can be used to set up PeMT and/or for providing training to the project team.
